### Anguttara Nikaya

The Further-factored (Numerical) Discourses or The Book of Gradual Sayings

Arranged numerically from ones to elevens; contains more elementary teaching for ordinary people than the preceding three

# Khuddaka Nikaya

The Minor Discourses

A miscellaneous collection of works in prose or verse; includes the Dhammapada

## Abhidhamma Pitaka

Schematic classification and analysis of doctrine from the Sutras

# Dhammasangani

Enumeration, definition, and classification of dhammas

### Vibhanga

The Book of Analysis; arranged by topic

#### Dhatukatha

Discourses on Elements; questions and answers

Description of individuals

### Kathavatthu

Debates on points of doctrine

The Book of Pairs
